

Setup

- 1) The video **must** be recorded **horizontally** (landscape view).
- 2) Good lighting conditions/camera handling
 - a. The video must not be recorded too dark/noisy
 - b. Avoid shaking the camera
- 3) General: Background, clothing etc.
 - a. Remember: A CLEAN background represents the farmer, the farm and coloQuick
 - b. Make sure that clothes and shoes are clean
 - c. Make sure that no footage shows the tube feeder
 - d. The farmer may not wear commercials for other products/brands
- 4) **Cover video footage** (this is used with the sound from the main interview video thus, the sound from cover footage is not used)
 - a. Sign or other with the name of the farm
 - b. The farm seen from outside
 - c. The customer standing by the system, showing how it is used
 - d. Overview of stable and calves
 - e. The customer walking down a stable aisle (optionally clapping a calf)

5) Interview

- a. The farmer must be holding a coloQuick cartridge
- b. The video must be a **one-take** (no interruptions)
- c. If possible, make 2 successful recordings (so that there is something to choose from)
- d. Maximum length on each clip: 30-45 seconds
- e. The farmer must speak loud and clear
- f. Pay attention to loud background noise (avoid high sounds from cows and machinery)







Playbook

- **Introduction**: The farmer tells:
 - o HIS/HER NAME
 - THE NAME OF THE FARM
 - LOCATION
 - **O COUNTRY**
 - o **NUMBER OF COWS**
 - o And answers the question: WHAT HAS COLOQUICK GIVEN YOU?
